

# Austrians 1859 to 1866 in 6mm

The miniatures are all from the Heroics & Ros Franco-Prussian War range unless noted otherwise.

## INFANTRY

**Line with Greatcoats:** To depict Austrians with rolled greatcoats use Prussian Jaegers NCP 3 Prussian Jaegers Advancing (Franco-Prussian War range - good headgear) and/or MPN 1 Prussian Musketeers and MPN 11 Prussian Musketeers Attacking (Prussian Napoleonic range. Both need work on headgear but you can use the Prussian shako as it is).

**Line with "bonnet de police":** NCF 8 French Guard Infantry Marching or NCF 9 Guard Infantry Attacking (Franco Prussian War range. You will need to cut off the pompons).

**Line:** MBN 19 Napoleonic British Infantry Attacking in shakos or even MBN 22 Infantry Belgic Attacking (with attention to headgear) (Napoleonic range).

**Chasseurs/Jaegers:** MAN 3 Austrian Jaegers Skirmishing (Napoleonic range - in hats) or NCP 3 Prussian Jaegers (Franco-Prussian War range).

## CAVALRY

**Uhlans:** NCP 4 Prussian Uhlans or NCP 5 Prussian Uhlans Charging or NCF 12 French Lancers.

**Hussars:** NCF 5 French Hussars (in kepis) (Franco-Prussian War range) or MACW 4 Federal Cavalry ACW Federal cavalry and MACW 14 Federal Cavalry in Kepi Charging (American Civil War range).

**Dragoons/Chevaux-Legers:** MAN 4 Austrian Napoleonic Dragoons (Napoleonic range) or NCP 14 Bavarian Light Horse (Franco-Prussian War range).

## ARTILLERY

**Artillery:** NCF 7 French Artillery.
