Within the Heroics and Ros Seven Years War range is MSY 34 North American Indians. This is suitable for Hurons, Iroquois, Mohicans. This pack also includes a selection of very useful Coureurs des Bois and Trappers. In addition to the miniatures in the Seven Years War range this document provides guidance on the use of other Heroics & Ros ranges, including the Renaissance, English Civil War, Marlborough Wars and Napoleonic Wars ranges.

For those wishing to model infantry deployed in two ranks with figures in different poses codes are presented as front rank and rear rank, those listed as rear rank are marching. For those preferring both ranks in a single pose miniatures in marching poses are generally recommended.

FRENCH

Line Infantry: MSY 11 Prussian Infantry Attacking or MSY 22 Austrian Infantry Firing. (1st rank) and MSY 29 Hungarian Infantry Marching (2nd rank). Alternatively MMF 2 French Grenadiers (1st rank) and MMF1 French infantry or MMB 1 British Infantry (2nd rank). The MMF and MMB packs are from the Marlborough Wars range.

Troupes Franches de la Marine: MSY 22 Ausrian Infantry Firing and MSY 17 Prussian Jaegers.

Canadian Militia: (Quebec, Trois Rivieres, Montreal) MSY 14 Prussian Grenadiers Firing. Some work is needed on headgear, specifically cutting the mitre down a little and giving it a round shape.

Artillery: MSY 4 Prussian Artillery or MSY 9 Austrian Artillery or MMO1 Artillery (from Marlborough period/range).

GREAT BRITAIN

Line Infantry: MSY 11 Prussian Musketeers Attacking or MSY 12 Prussian Musketeers Firing (1st rank) and MSY 1 Prussian Musketeers Marching (2nd rank).

Grenadiers: MSY 2 Prussian Grenadiers Marching or MSY 13 Prussian Grenadiers Attacking.

Scots Infantry: MECW 13 Scot Muskteers (in pants from ECW range) or MBN 5, 8 or 25 Scots (in kilt from British Napoleonic range).

American Levies/Militias: MSY 17 Prussian Jaegers (suitable for skirmish lines or double lines). In addition (and/or) MSY 11 Prussian Musketeers Attacking or MSY 12 Prussian Musketeers Firing or MSY 22 Austrian Musketeers Firing (1st rank). A mix of MSY 1 Prussian Musketeers Marching and MSY 29 Hungarian Musketeers. (2nd rank).

Rangers: MR 4 Spanish Arquebusiers (Renaissance range).

Artillery: MSY 4 Prussian Artillery or MSY 9 Austrian Artillery or MMO1 Artillery (from Marlborough period/range).
