

# Napoleonic Ottomans in 6mm

The miniatures have been selected from a range of different Heroics & Ros ranges, references are provided.

Please note that the descriptions for some of the codes below have changed over time, though the product code is constant. The original description, prefixed by “*previously*” is shown in italics which may be useful for some.

## INFANTRY & ARTILLERY

**Guards & Janissaries:** MR12 Polish Musketeers (Renaissance range). Alternately MACW 8 Zouaves (American Civil War range)\*

**Sebkhans:** MC 6 Pathan Tribesmen and / or MC 16 Mahdist Ansar Infantry *previously Dervish Infantry* (Colonial Wars range).

**Rayas:** MACW 17 Zouaves Skirmishing (American Civil War range) or MC 6 Pathan Tribesmen (Colonial Wars range).

**Arabian Sebkhans with Bows:** MCR 5 Saracen Infantry (Medieval range).

**Nizam i Jedid:** MSY 16 Prussian Fusiliers Attacking (Seven Years War range. Some work needed on caps). Alternately MACW 17 Zouaves Skirmishing (American Civil War range) \*

**Derbent etc:** A mix of some MSY 8 Croat Grenzers (Seven Years War range) and MC 6 Pathan Tribesmen (Colonial Wars range).

**Artillery:** MC 19 Mahdist Artillery *previously Dervish Artillery* (Colonial Wars range. Use the figures with a mix of French Napoleonic guns & mortars. In addition MWR 17 Artillery. (Wars of the Roses range. Renaissance guns from MR 3 Artillery may also be used).

## CAVALRY

**Suvarileri:** MC 1 Bengal Lancers.or MC 17 Mahdist Ansar Cavalry *previously Dervish Cavalry*. (Both from the Colonial Wars range. Both require home made round shields and may require modification or removal of the fanion).

**Mameluks:** MFN 24A Mamelukes of the Guard (French Napoleonic range).

**Sihlatar Guards:** MRN 6 Cossacks (Russian Napoleonic range).

**Yoruks:** MRN 6 Cossacks (Russian Napoleonic range).

**Djellis:** MFN 24A Mamelukes of the Guard (French Napoleonic range).

**Sipahis:** MSY 19 Prussian Lancers *previously Prussian Bosniak Lancers* (Seven Years War range).

**Tatars etc:** MR 11 Tatar Cavalry (Renaissance range). Alternately MCR 4 Saracens Cavalry (Medieval & Crusade range or MR 10 Cossack Cavalry (Renaissance range) \*.
